Arrival in Auckland

Auckland - Waitomo

Today we leave Auckland behind and head south through the picturesque farmland of the Waikato region towards our destination: Waitomo.

Here we can find one of the most unforgettable attractions in this area, the famous Waitomo Caves. These caves are so well-known because of their unique inhabitants – Glow worms. Board a boat for a totally unforgettable experience as you glide through the caves under a sky of thousands of twinkling glow worms and be mesmerised by their magical luminescent glow.

You have the option to include Ruakuri Cave (longest underground guided walking tour) and Aranui Cave (collection of spectacular cave formations) tours which can also be combined with cave tubing, abseiling, rappelling and waterfall climbs.

We finish up the day at Altura Park, which is where we spend the night in their farm stay accommodation. All guests get entry to the gardens and wildlife park so take some time to explore before you head to bed in your fully-equipped unit.

Waitomo - New Plymouth

Leaving Waitomo behind, we journey to New Plymouth, the biggest city in the Taranaki Region on the west coast of the North Island. See the towering snow-topped Mount Taranaki which holds pride of place overlooking the region. Our visit here would not be complete without a memorable helicopter flight experience to view this spectacular region by air.

Back on land, pay a visit to Pukekura Park – you will recognise this large park after seeing it from your aerial view, now take the time to explore the 128 acres of varying landscape by foot, encompassing exotic trees, gardens, lakes and walking trails which lead us through stunning native bush.

Make sure you have some comfy walking shoes because after lunch we head to New Plymouth's stunning Coastal Walkway – a 7km path which stretches almost from one end of the city to the other. From this walkway we can enjoy spectacular views of the west coast. Beaches, playgrounds cafes and local shops are also easily accessed from the Coastal Walkway.

Experience life on a deer farm with our accommodation at Egmont Deer Farmstay. During our stay, spend time around the farm with various animals including quiet, hand-reared lambs, calves and hinds. Your accommodation is modern, self-contained quarters which include a bathroom and kitchen.

New Plymouth - Taupo (through the Forgotten World Highway)

Today we'll have a fascinating journey to an unforgettable destination. We start the day travelling towards Taupo on the remote and mysterious Forgotten World Highway. Along the way we'll see evidence of communities that once existed in this land and glimpses of 'the way it was'.

Taupo is located in the heart of the North Island alongside Lake Taupo, the largest freshwater lake in Australasia, and undoubtedly one of the most spectacular areas of the country.

On our visit to Taupo, we spend time at Huka Falls, an amazing natural spectacle with breath-taking power. You'll have the best view in the house from your seat on a purposebuilt riverboat. Take in the glistening crystal clear water, the birdlife, and native bush which lines the riverbanks. At Aratiatia Rapids, the dam gates open and turn the quiet water into turbulent rapids in an impressive display of nature's power.

Tonight we stay at world-renowned Huka Lodge, an iconic New Zealand retreat which offers an unrivalled location on the edge of the Waikato River. There are several accommodation suites for you to choose from, set on 17-acres of manicured grounds.

Taupo - Rotorua

Leaving Taupo we head to Rotorua which is unlike anywhere else in the world, with deeprooted Maori culture and fascinating natural sights such as exploding geysers, steaming lakes, and the Pink and White terraces – not to mention its distinctive sulphur smell. (Don't worry, you eventually get used to it!).

Just 20 minutes south of Rotorua is Wai-O-Tapu Thermal Wonderland. Wai-O-Tapu stands for 'sacred waters' and you'll certainly feel like you are somewhere special as you walk at your own pace through the unique natural features of this park which have been sculptured out of thermal activity – thousands of years in the making - including the naturally coloured hot and cold pools, the world famous Champagne Pool, bubbling mud and steaming craters. Be sure to check out the Lady Knox geyser which erupts daily – a rare opportunity to see volcanic activity up close.

Take some time to relax and unwind at the Polynesian Spa, one of New Zealand's oldest and most well-known spas internationally. Indulge your senses on the shores of Lake Rotorua in the unique hot mineral pools with stunning views over the lake. Go all out and experience ultimate relaxation with a spa therapy in the Lake Spa Retreat and afterwards enjoy culinary delights at the cafe.

Feel at home at the Tumbledown Hill bed and breakfast, our accommodation for the night. Take some time out on the peaceful farm retreat located in scenic Paradise Valley. Paradise Valley is a beautiful valley located between Ngongotaha and Rotorua city.
